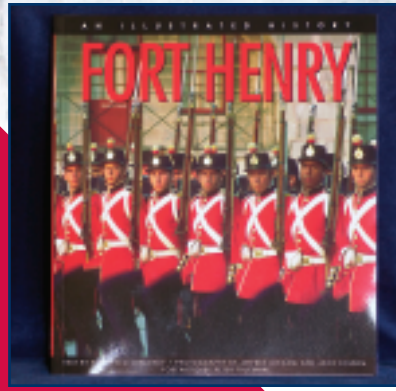
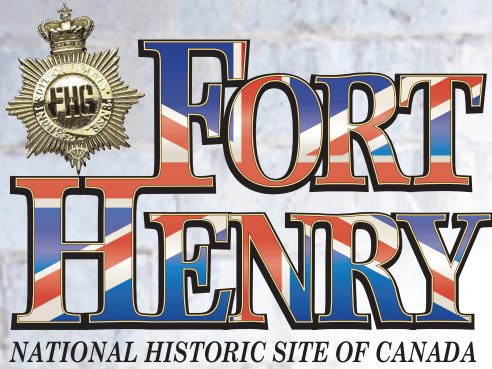


# FORT HENRY NATIONAL HISTORIC SITE OF CANADA RETAIL PRODUCTS

## *Fort Henry Hat*

In 1861 The British Army copied the hat then used by the French. The new "chaco" (pronounced "sha-ko") was 10cm high at the front and 17cm high at the back. This is what was worn by soldiers in battle. It was made of cork covered with dark blue cloth. The cloth was stitched to the cork so that the chaco would keep it's shape when wet. This gave it a quilted look. At the front was a leather peak to shade the eyes. This shako is made of sturdy cardstock and provides a realistic reproduction for kids of all ages.



## *Cannon*

Representative of an 1860's die-cast cannon. Appropriate to the site and period of history. A variety of other period cannon pieces are also available.



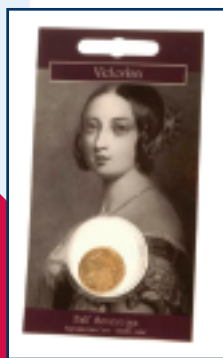
## *Reproduction Fife*

The Fife was a main instrument for military and social life. It was used to signal commands in battle as well as to fife instructions for routine Fort life. The fife is a 6 holed instrument, in the key of B, this 16 inch plastic instrument comes with basic music instructions allowing you to recreate a bit of history and enjoy the music of the fifes in your home.



## *Bugle*

The soldiers were not wealthy enough to own a watch, therefore the changing of the guard and posting sentries for the night were signaled with bugle calls of "Last Post" and "Lights Out".



## *Victorian Coin*

Officers were required to pay for clothing, food, servants and weapons. Overseas trade the lifeblood of the British economy was increased during Queen Victoria's reign. (1819-1901) This reproduction Coin is a Half Sovereign - double sided



## *Wax Seal Kit*

Wax seals were traditionally used to secure and safeguard correspondence. A touch of old world class and elegance for any office, library or schoolroom.
