MEAL SUGGESTIONS

 Because of health guidelines, and to preserve as much as possible an historic flavour, if you choose to bring your own meals, we suggest that the foods could be among the following:

LUNCH

Bag lunch, fresh or canned goods which can be easily transported and heated and served in your own vessels, (soup, stew, etc), bread, butter, pre-packaged biscuits, milk, tea, coffee, juice.

SUPPER

Fresh or Canned goods which can be heated and served in your own vessels (soup, stew, etc.), cheese, raw vegetables and fruit, milk, tea, coffee, juice, bread, butter, preserves, pre-packaged biscuits.

SNACK

Pre-packaged biscuits, milk, and/or juice.

BREAKFAST

Cold cereal, oatmeal, bread, cheese, tea, coffee, milk, juice, and preserves.



PRE-VISIT CHECKLIST

For maximum involvement and enjoyment, please consider the following points for your child.

- 1) **Comfortable, warm clothing** enough for two full days, dress for the weather! Flat shoes
 - i. or boots, a sweater, durable pants, extra socks and underwear, etc. Do not pack your
 - ii. "Sunday Best", as soldiers work hard!
- 2) Sleeping Bag and pillow.
- 3) Toiletries such as toothbrush and paste, facecloth, soap.
- 4) Eating utensils if required. If the class has not opted for additionally purchased Food Services, they will be required to bring their own utensils. These should consist of the following:
 - iii. One pie plate or similar dish made of tin, aluminium, or enamel;
 - iv. One knife, fork, and spoon;
 - v. One drinking vessel made of tin, aluminium, or enamel if possible. If not, an unbreakable mug is advisable.
- 5) Modernisms such as make-up and most costume jewellery (earrings, nail polish, necklaces, etc.) are inappropriate and should be left at home.
- 6) Please ensure your child leaves valuables at home. Fort Henry cannot accept responsibility for any lost, broken, or stolen items.
